A photograph that captures **good imaging technique, highlighting pathology**. Your captured image could be an OCT, OCTA, Colour fundus image, slitlamp image or Angiography single image.

- Clinical intrigue
- The beauty of pathology
- A compelling story in a single image

Please include:

- Institution
- Ophthalmic photographer's name
- One clinician involved in the case
- A legend of **50 words or fewer**
